



# **2008 JOHOR OPEN U-14 VOLLEYBALL CHAMPIONSHIP**

## **COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS**

### **1. ORGANISERS**

Kota Tinggi Volleyball Association (KTVA) shall organise the **2007 JOHOR OPEN U-14 VOLLEYBALL CHAMPIONSHIP**

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### **2. DATES & VENUES**

The competition shall be held on the following dates and venues:

#### 2.1 Boy & Girl Game

2.1.1 Dates : 02-03 AUG 2008  
2.1.2 Venues : Gel SRJK@ Pei Hwa, Kota Tinggi

### **3. PARTICIPATING TEAMS**

- 3.1 The Championship is reserved for the **JAVA** Affiliate, School, Club and Associate Members whose financial obligations are in good order and by invitation of the KTVA Executive Board.
- 3.2 Affiliate and Associate Members are allowed to register ONE MEN & ONE WOMAN team only.
- 3.3 A team is composed of 16 persons (Manager, Chief Coach, Assistant Coach, Trainer/ Chaperon, + 12 players).

### **4. ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS**

- 4.1 This competition is only open to Johor player and must be born on or after 1st January 1994

- 4.2 Players below the age of 21 must obtain a parental/guardian's written consent.

## **5. CONFIRMATION, REGISTRATION & GENERAL TECHNICAL MEETING**

### **5.1 Confirmation of Participation**

- 5.1.1 Not later than 20<sup>th</sup> July 2008, team must send PVA E 02 Form (Confirmation of Participation) to the Secretariat.

### **5.2 Registration of 12 Players**

- 5.2.1 Not later than 20<sup>th</sup> July 2008, every participating team must send its team list of 12 players (KTVA O-2 bis Form) together with 2 photos of each team member to the Secretariat..
- 5.2.2 Any change of players listed in the PVA O-2 bis form before the match begins, is permitted on the condition that the listed player has the relevant legal and authorised document to warrant the change.
- 5.2.3 A maximum change of 2 players is allowed under item 6.2.2.

### **5.3 General Technical Meeting**

All Managers/Coaches MUST attend the General Technical Meeting on 04<sup>th</sup> Aug 2008 (Friday) at 20:00 hours in Kota Tinggi. Each team must submit the followings to the Secretariat:-

- 5.4.1 a photostated NRIC or passport of every players
- 5.4.2 official logo/emblem/badge of the team
- 5.4.3 registration fee of RM 100 for each team

- 5.5 All matters pertaining to eligibility, status and registration of players shall be discussed and solved in this session.

## **6. COMPETITION SYSTEM**

- 6.1 The competition system is subject to the exact number of participating teams. KTVA will forward to each participating team a finalized competition system and competition calendar one week before the Championship.

## **7. DRAWING OF LOTS**

- 7.1 Drawing of lots will take place during the - 24 July 2008, 15:00 hrs in Kota Tinggi.
- 7.2 Within a week after the draw, the organisers shall prepare the matches calendar and distribute to the teams and all concerned.

## **8. CLASSIFICATION OF SYSTEM**

- 8.1.1 The following points shall be taken into account to decide the ranking : –
- a. match won = 2 points,
  - b. match lost = 1 point,
  - c. forfeit/disqualification = 0 point.
- 8.1.2 In the case of a tie in points, the POINTS RATIO shall be calculated and the team with the higher quotient will be declared the winner.
- 8.1.3 If the Sets Ratio results in the case of a tie again, then the SETS RATIO shall be calculated and the team with the higher quotient will be declared the winner.
- 8.1.4 If both Sets And Points Ratio are in a tie, the match won by the team in the previous week will be declared the winner.

## **9. APPEALS**

- 9.1 All appeals must be made to the Panel of Jury by the Team Coach at any time of the match when he detected a wrong situation or a decision made not according to the existing Rules & Regulations.
- 9.2 Validity of the Case Referred  
The Case Referred must be related to:
- 9.2.1 A decision made by the referees not based on the current FIVB Rules of the Game or the referees refuse to be responsible for any decision made.
- 9.2.2 A wrong decision made by the scorer on the service order or allocation of points.

9.3 Unwarranted Case

- 9.3.1 Against the decision of the referees on the playing actions of players,
- 9.3.2 Against the decision of the referees on the disciplinary sanctions made on team members.
- 9.3.4 The Coach who made an unwarranted case of appeal shall be sanctioned with a 'WARNING'. Further repetition of the same nature shall entail the DISQUALIFICATION of the Coach for the match involved only.

9.4 Meeting of Jury

- 9.4.1 In a case of involving the decision of the referees, the Jury-on-Duty shall instruct the relevant refereeing corps members (R1 or R2) to attend the Meeting of Jury.
- 9.4.2 In a case of involving a line call, the Jury-on-Duty shall instruct the relevant refereeing corps members (LJ) to attend the Meeting of Jury.
- 9.4.3 In a case of involving the record of points, service order and positioning of players, the Jury-on-Duty shall instruct the relevant refereeing corps members (scorer or assistant scorer) to attend the Meeting of Jury.
- 9.4.4 No other person is allowed to attend the Assembly of Jury without the authorisation of the Jury-on-Duty.
- 9.4.5 The Panel of Jury shall solve the appeal in the shortest possible time so as not to prolong the match unnecessary.

9.5 Decision of Jury

- 9.5.1 If the case is accepted, the decision of the referees or the scorers shall be rectified. Match shall resume with the new team positions or new score.
- 9.5.2 If the case is rejected, the match continues as usual with the same team position and score. Disciplinary action shall be taken against the Team Coach as in 10.3.2 and 10.3.3
- 9.5.3 The decision of the Jury shall be communicated to the referees, scorers, captains and the announcer to be announced to the spectators.
- 9.5.4 Decision of the Jury is FINAL.

**10. OFFICIAL RULES OF THE GAME**

10.1 Game Rules

- 10.1.1 The competition shall be played in accordance with the latest FIVB Rules of the Game (2005-2008 Edition) with any amendments approved by the FIVB.

10.2 Team Members Attire

- 10.2.1 Team Officials sitting on the bench must wear proper uniform attire with shoes. No shorts are allowed.
- 10.2.2 Teams Players except the Libero player must be in proper and uniform playing attire as follows:
  - a. jerseys and shorts of similar colour and pattern;
  - b. numbers of the approved size printed on the front and back of the jerseys.

10.3 Refereeing Corps

- 10.3.1 Qualified and neutral refereeing corps will be appointed by the Organising Committee.

10.4 Others

- 10.4.1 All interpretations and clarifications will be made during the General Technical Meeting.

**11. AWARDS**

- 11.1. Champion : 12 medal + 12 t-shirt
- 11.1. Runner-up : 12 medal
- 11.1. 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner-up : 12 medal

**12. TEAM OBLIGATIONS**

- 12.1 Each team will be responsible and obliged to the followings :
  - 12.1.1 Entry Fee of RM 100.00 for each team.
  - 12.1.2 Transport, Board & Lodging during the Competition.
  - 12.1.3 Attend all functions; meetings, press conference, ceremonies, matches, etc.

**13. UNFORESEEN ITEMS**

The Organising Committee reserves the right to make decision pertaining to any matter/problem arising which are not mentioned in the Rules & Regulations. The decision is final.
